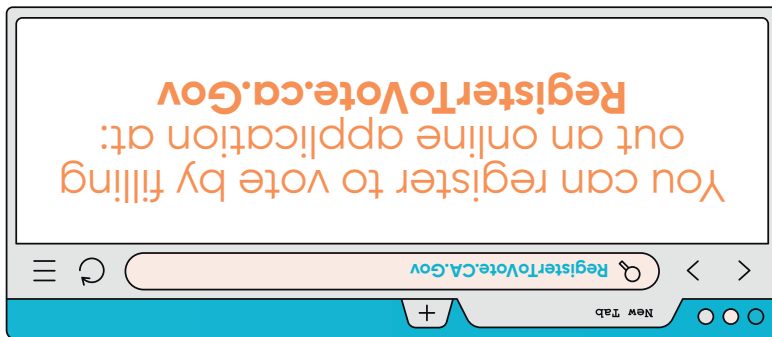


How do I register to vote?

Register Online



To register online, you will need the following information:

- ✓ First and Last Name
- ✓ Your Date of Birth
- ✓ Your California Driver License or California Identification Card number
- ✓ The last four digits of your Social Security number

Register by Mail



You can grab a free application at a local library, the Department of Motor Vehicles office, or a U.S. post office.

You can also request an application be mailed to you by calling (800) 345-8683.

If you're on parole, your parole officer **may** also provide a voter registration form.

And you CAN vote while on parole in California! (Thanks to Proposition 17, passed in 2020.)

If you register by mail don't forget to mail in your application at least **15 days** before the next election

If you or a loved one are in jail and eligible to vote, **you are entitled to receive a voter registration card!**
